Size: Horizontal or Vertical design
5" inches x 7" inches / 12.7 cm x 17.7 cm

Your artwork MUST include the message, ***"May Peace Prevail On Earth"*** in English and/or your Native Language. All art must be done by children, including the writing of **May Peace Prevail On Earth**.
